Airport Schönefeld: regional train RE7 direction Bad Belzig to Zoologischer Garten

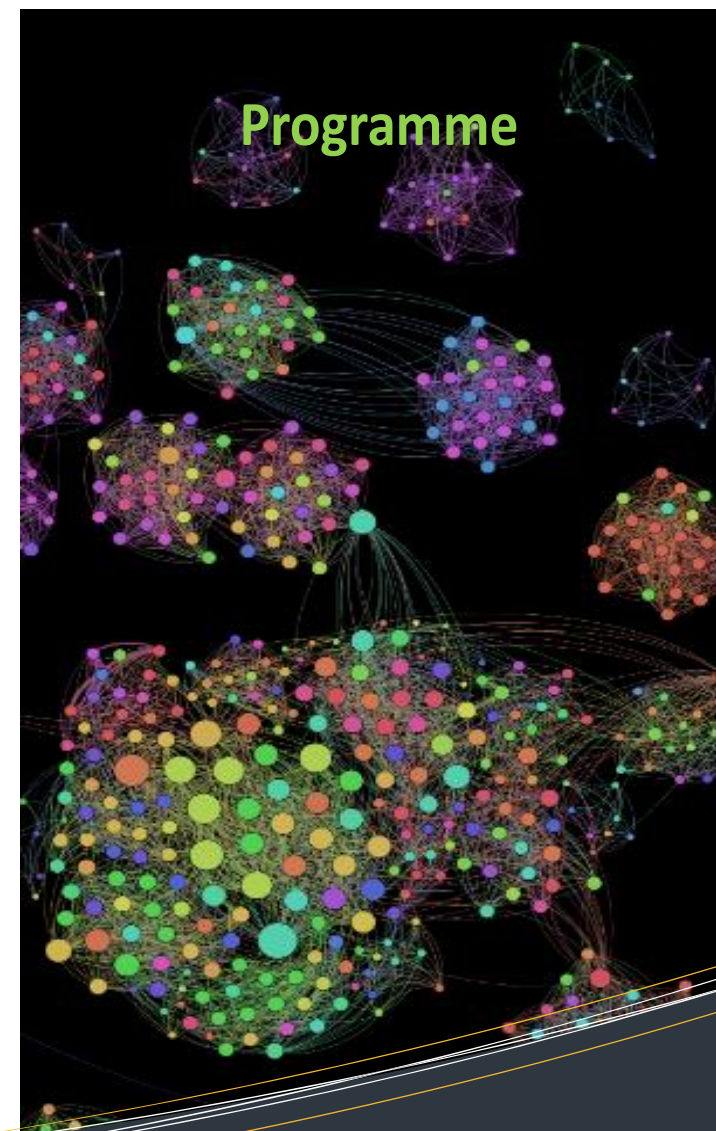
